#### Happy Families game - famous women edition

In this traditional Happy Families game, the player are invited to reconstruct families of famous women divided into the following categories:

- Tech
- Science
- Politics
- Literature
- Painting

Additional cards are included on which the players can find the names of these famous women sorted by families to ease the game.

This game is played like a basic Happy Families, the only difference being that the families are composed of 5 members, and that there are 5 families.

To spice up the game, the players can refer to the cards by describing the achievements of the women on the card.
